Tuesday - PRAY to God for someone close to you who needs God's help Let God's light show you the way and continue to pray for this person's need.

Wednesday – LISTEN to God who sent His Holy Spirit to comfort you and also listen to the needs of others who you can help. God sees not only in the visible spectrum where our eyes work, but in all of the other spectrum wavelengths.

Thursday – FAST by refraining from eating food and seek to know God in a significantly deeper prayer experience.

Friday – ENCOURAGE each other by recalling various highlights when God provided our needs precisely when we most needed them.

Saturday - THANK GOD for His indescribable gift of grace in Christ, Christ's healing ministry, Christ's deliverance from sin, and for the faith of fellow Christians (His "Light and Salt of the world.")
