Palm Sunday – TODAY – Immediately following the service, all are invited to gather in the main hallway near the Sandy Ridge doors and we will form a procession out to a spot near the playground and pavilion where we will plant a tree. This tree will symbolize our losses, struggles and suffering; and our faith and hope in God to bring new life out of those difficult experiences. Coffee, tea and doughnuts will be available in the pavilion for refreshment afterward.

Fruit for the Cross – Pick up a fruit shape on the sanctuary table near the prayer room. Take it home, decorate it and give it a name (one of the 9 fruits of the Spirit) and <u>bring it Easter morning</u> to hang on our cross! The fruit will hang there, along with our struggles and losses, as an act of faith that our God brings fruit in the midst of suffering.

Good Friday – April 7th @ 7:30pm – We will gather in the sanctuary for a worship service remembering Jesus' sacrifice and crucifixion.

Easter Sunday – April 9th - Breakfast & Worship – All are welcome to come for breakfast in the Fellowship Hall at 8:30am. There is a signup sheet on the table near the mailboxes – add your name to bring baked goods, breakfast casseroles or fruit for the buffet. A worship service celebrating Jesus' resurrection will follow at 10:00am and will include communion!

Prayer Guide:

2023 Theme - Spirit-Produced Fruit

Monday – Pray with the Old Testament prophet: "Hosanna! Blessed is the One who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in highest heaven!" Repeat these words several times at each meal today.

Tuesday – Pray for all those in our nation affected by gun violence. Pray for peace.

Wednesday – Ask God to help you notice someone who needs encouragement today. Hold them before the Lord in prayer. Listen for how God might invite you to reach out to them and take action.

Thursday – Pray for the children of our congregation and your neighborhood. Pray that the love of Jesus will touch them and give them new life.

Friday – Prayerfully read John 19:17-30, the crucifixion of Jesus. Talk to God about what you notice in this text and how it impacts your emotions and thoughts.

Saturday – As you anticipate the hope and new life of Easter, offer to God any areas of your life where you are still waiting for resolution, for answers, for healing, for hope. Trust God's Loving Presence with you in the waiting.
