5<sup>th</sup> Sunday Days of Service update- Ministry Leadership Team thanks all who completed surveys. Things people found most helpful about the experience: "working together toward a common goal, getting to know individuals in a way that doesn't happen while sitting in worship, a new way of learning to worship, a nice break from routine, experiences at A Woman's Place and Ripple were enlightening." While many affirmed the Days of Service, we did receive 5 comments out of 20 that did not appreciate doing this on a Sunday. After discussing the surveys, MLT decided to reduce our 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday Days of Service from 4 to 3 for the coming year. We will have worship here at DMC on January 30th, and practice days of service in May, July and October. Thank you again for your feedback.
