Crafted Prayer for DMC for 2021 – We will meet to craft a prayer for DMC for the new year. We will meet on Sundays, January 10 and 24 (11-am – 12 noon) either in person (in the fellowship hall) or via zoom depending on how we meet for worship those days. The process includes times of listening, sharing and discerning together to hear what God wants for DMC in the 2021. Please contact Sandy if you are interested.

2021 Theme- Our worship and preaching theme for the new year is: **Look instead for what God can do!** It comes from the story of the healing of the blind man in John 9. When the disciples asked who sinned to cause his blindness, Jesus replied that no one had and encouraged them to focus on what God would do in the midst of the situation. *How might we enter 2021 also looking for what God can do in and through our circumstances?*

Discipleship in 2021- Pastoral staff will be offering a monthly spiritual formation focus throughout the year. Watch for newsletter articles, devotional emails, and other invitations to connect with scripture as we "look for what God can do in us" in 2021.
