Notice the promise of good things.

What are two pitfalls?

Prayer Guide:

2023 Theme – Spirit-Produced Fruit

Monday – Ask God for an awareness today of when the Spirit is producing fruit in your relationships. Give thanks for the power of the Spirit at work in you.

Tuesday – Pray for the church in Europe today. Pray for encouragement, wisdom and perseverance as followers of Jesus do Kingdom work there.

Wednesday – Pray for those who are incarcerated today, and for those who lead Bible studies and prayer groups in local jails/prisons. Pray for God to bring hope, peace and renewal to these men and women.

Thursday – Repeat this prayer 5x at each meal today: (as you breathe in) “Spirit of Jesus...” (and as you breathe out) “give me _____ to share today.” (choose one to fill in the blank: love, joy, peace patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control)

Friday – Pray for the organization “Hands in Service” today, where we have served during one of our 5th Sunday Days of Service. Pray for the leadership and staff and for those who receive assistance from Hands in Service.

Saturday – As we prepare for worship tomorrow, pray the Lord’s Prayer: “Our Father in Heaven, hallowed be Your Name. Your Kingdom come; Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread and forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us. Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. For Yours is the Kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.”
