Two baskets are available on the front table in the sanctuary, to drop in your offering either before or after the service. **Masks & Physical Distancing-** Thank you for wearing your mask for the duration of the time we are in the building. To encourage physical distance, blue tape is marking spots on the benches where people are being requested to sit. Each spot represents a family unit, whether that is one person or more. There are red, yellow, and green stickers available in each lobby. You may wear one to indicate what kind of interaction you desire from others (red-please respect 6 ft. distance, yellow-no physical touch, green-elbow bump accepted).
