Friday – Pray for Worthwhile Ministries / The Well, as they work with survivors of human trafficking. Pray for healing and freedom for the clients and wisdom for the staff and leadership.

Saturday – Find a few minutes to pray in this way today: (as you breathe in) "Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God" (and as you breathe out) "Have mercy on me, a sinner." Repeat this prayer at least six times; receive God's mercy and forgiveness.
