Sermon Notes: Matthew 6:12, 14-15 & 2 Corinthians 5:14-21

What is clear from these 2 passages?

What is the typical response to sin?

What might happen if forgiveness flowed freely?

What hinders us from forgiving more freely?

<u>Prayer Guide</u>: 2022 Theme – *Searching for the Source*

Monday- Thank God for the generous grace offered through forgiveness. Ask God to fill you with an increased awareness of the freedom given through forgiveness.

Tuesday- Pray for the women participating in training today at DMC through A Woman's Place. Pray that they will be confident and have hope for their families.

Wednesday- Pray for those in our church who own their own business. Pray that God will give them wisdom for any decisions they face and for the ability to communicate with their employees and clients.

Thursday- Ask God to identify ways in your life that forgiveness could be a powerful resource to bring freedom to you and your relationships.

Friday- Ask God to allow you to see how each person you encounter today is created in God's image.

Saturday- Ask God to give you a song, phrase, or scripture on which to focus today as you prepare for worship tomorrow.
