FIVE PRINCIPLES OF BODY BUILDING - Part 2 (1 Corinthians 12:12-27)

- Scripture uses the metaphor of a body to describe the church
- The church at Corinth was strongly influenced by the spirit of the city
- The church was characterized by a party spirit, both morally and politically
 - [°] The moral party spirit led to immorality in the church, so Paul encourages progress in purity
 - The political party spirit led to divisions in the church, so Paul encourages progress in unity
 - [°] Addressing unity in chapter 12, the apostle lists principles of how the body functions best

The body functions best when:

- 1) The parts are accountable to the whole (12-13)
- 2) The parts accept themselves (7-11, 18)
- 3) The parts accept each other (14-20, 22-23)
- 4) The parts acknowledge they need each other (18-21)
- 5) The parts care for and support each other (25-26)

What principles of "body building" do our muscular, green, Hulk Hands illustrate?
